Respected Chairman, Governing Board Members and International Advisory Council Members,

We are pleased to inform you of the outcome of the latest Residents' Assembly Decision (RAD) to pass Resolution No.RAD/04/2022. Please find enclosed the announcement and signed resolution.

An unprecedented and clear statement has been made by the Residents' Assembly (RA) in the form of a resolution that was passed by 97% of the 1161 eligible participants in the process. (Please note that this is the highest participation by the RA in Auroville's history, having tripled since last year.) This resolution affirms the membership of the groups and committees listed in Annexure 2 as bonafide representatives of the RA. It also confirms that none of the appointments listed in Annexure 1 were made through any consultative process with the RA. As resolved by the RA, the affirmed members of the working groups and committees are available for working together in a spirit of 'mutuality' and 'brotherhood' with the Governing Board and International Advisory Council.

We would like to make our earnest request to you to instruct the Secretary to cancel the Office orders (and other orders) listed in Annexure 1 and engage with representatives authorized by the RA. Additionally, we request that the management of AuroNet and the auroville.org.in email domain is returned to the previous teams who have the confidence of the community. This would help immensely in taking steps towards coming out of the current impasse to build the Auroville International Township in a true spirit of Unity.

As directed by the RA we affirm to follow the judgment of the Hon'ble the Madras High Court in letter and spirit.


We are committed to help the Office of the Secretary to complete the Register of Residents.


